
ARTICLE 11 – VISITOR POLICY

Statement of Intent

While CIC is committed to ensuring that students assimilate into the community and are able to grow with friends and family, CIC also recognizes that any visitors shall at no time deter, interfere or distract a student from his or her academic or personal development. Any student that uses the services of an individual (CIC student or otherwise) to impersonate themselves for the purposes of violating a CIC policy will be subjected to a CICDC Expulsion hearing. This refers but is not limited to: having someone sleep in residence, serve ACTS, sign up for tutoring, community service hours.

1. Policy

All visitors to CIC premises must report to the CIC Security Office or designated residence front desk and provide a valid photo ID before proceeding through any area of the school or residence. A visitor is any person who is not a CIC staff or current student residing in that residence.

Any parents/guardians wishing to meet with their child and his or her teachers or other CIC staff, are encouraged to notify the office in advance so that appointments may be scheduled at a time that is convenient for all. To arrange Residence tours, contact housing cic-totalcare.com in advance.

Consequences for Breach of Policy

CIC Security will conduct an investigation. Students acting in contravention of this policy may be directed to the Principal or Designate who shall determine the appropriate consequence, which may include the disciplinary measures as set out in Article 16 herein.
