

## Quarantine Acknowledgment and Confirmation

To limit the spread of COVID-19, travelers entering Canada must follow the rules set out by the emergency orders under the *Quarantine Act*. Please read and acknowledge the following:

- I have read the Welcome to Canada document provided by Columbia International College (CIC)
- I will not travel when sick or exhibiting any symptoms related to COVID.
- I will self-monitor for any COVID related symptoms in the week leading up to my arrival in Canada
- I am aware that when entering Canada, Canadian border officials will ask:
  - if I have a cough, fever or difficulty breathing
  - if I have a suitable place to isolate or quarantine, where I won't be in contact with vulnerable populations
  - that I won't be in a group or community living arrangement during quarantine
- I confirm that I will answer all questions asked by Canadian border officials truthfully
- I am aware that I must use ArriveCAN or call 1-833-641-0343 to:
  - confirm that you've arrived at the address you provided for your quarantine or isolation location within 48 hours of your entry into Canada
  - complete daily COVID-19 symptom self-assessments during your quarantine period
- I am aware that I will be required to quarantine for 21 days if I don't have symptoms or if I have symptoms
- I am aware that if I choose to quarantine at a location other than at Columbia International College (e.g. at a relatives), I will still be required to quarantine at CIC for 21 days in order to attend in-person classes.
- I am aware of the consequences of violating the quarantine requirements set by the government of Canada and Columbia International College.
