## November 7, 2023: Placement Assessments

## (Online Live Group Session)

Placement Assessments are mandatory, and you must attend on the scheduled date.

Each student will receive an invitation link for the placement assessment by email.

We request you complete the assessments honestly so that the results accurately represent your work for appropriate placement purposes. An inaccurate assessment will result in an inappropriate class level placement that will negatively impact your academic performance and progress. We wish to set you up for success.

All CIC assessments will be completed remotely and will be invigilated by CIC staff.

- Please make sure your device(s) is/are in good working condition with a functioning camera and speaker. A laptop or desktop is highly recommended.
- Two devices (a laptop/computer, a phone and/or an iPad) are highly recommended.
- The duration of each subject assessment will be about 90 minutes long.
- All subject assessments will be conducted in one day.

## **English Assessment**

- Students must submit their IELTS/TOFEL/Duolingo test score to CIC before the Placement Assessment Day November 7, 2023. Send your score to <a href="mailto:guidancecounsellors@cic-totalcare.com">guidancecounsellors@cic-totalcare.com</a>
- Students who have IELTS/TOEFL/Duolingo scores may be exempted from writing CIC's English Assessment.
- Students who may not have IELTS/TOEFL/Duolingo scores will write CIC's English Assessment.
- CIC's English assessment scores will take precedence over other test results.
