Peer tutoring is a program in which students are tutored by other students



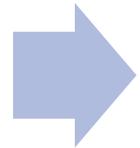
It provides an opportunity to learn from your classmates and peers who are familiar with the course content

Peer tutoring can begin!

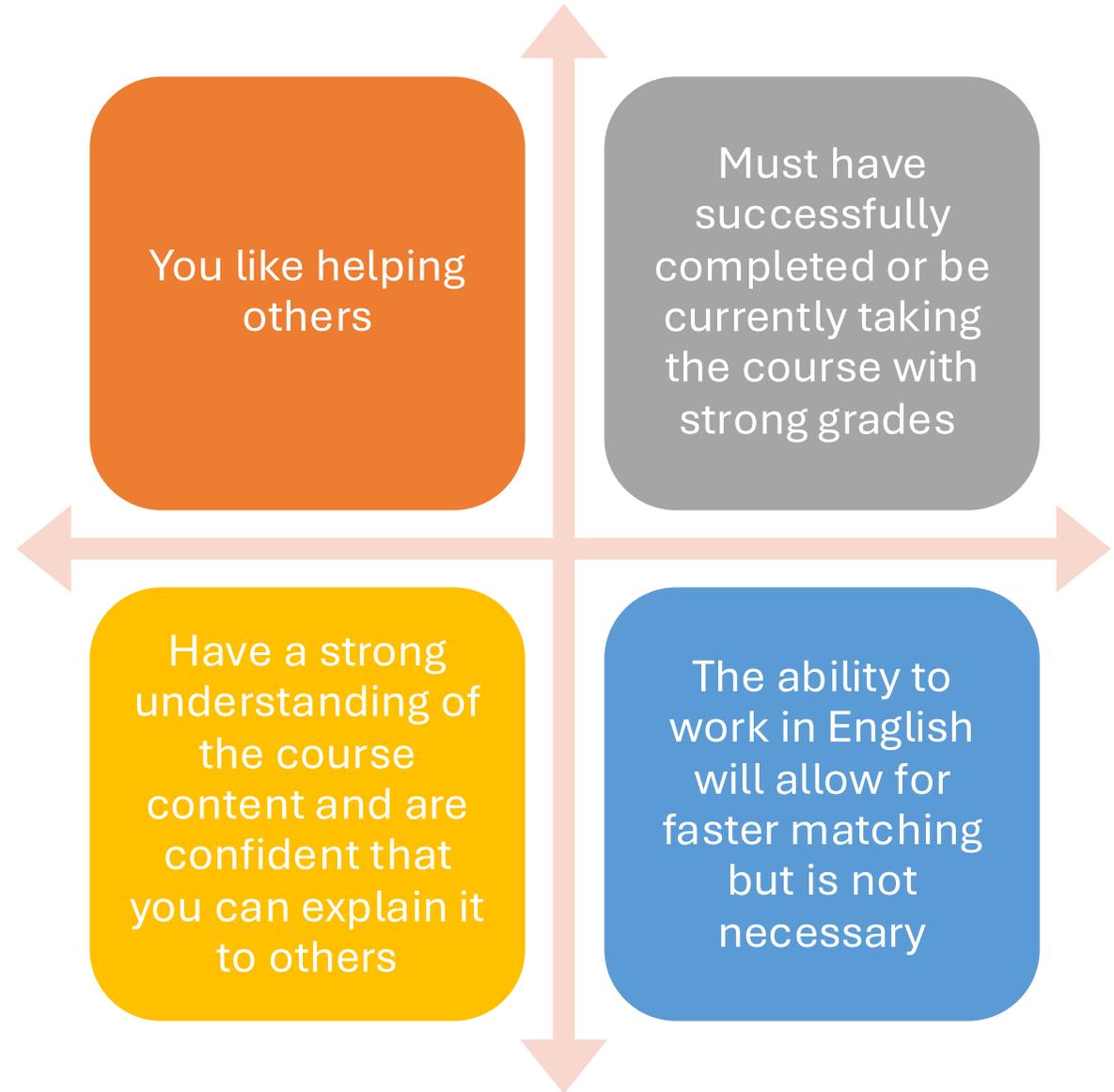


Once connected students can arrange their own schedules and meet up times as needed
